SAFE CHILDHOOD- PREVENTING & FIGHTING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE (CSA)

Interactive, narrative workshops to create awareness against child sexual abuse with a child-centered approach. Sensitized children aged 3-16 on Personal Safety Education. Trained teachers, doctors, caregivers, social workers on handling disclosures, creating safe spaces and being alert to CSA. Shared handouts, resources and hotline numbers for surviving children or their caregivers.

Reached 500+ children and 200+ adults through Safe Childhood



"Apart from personal safety session with the children, mothers were sensitized on how to be aware of safe and unsafe situations for their children, understanding that many times abusers can be immediate family members, and other realities of child sexual abuse.

Mothers learned how to identify signs of abuse in children through behavioral changes. I think these sessions should be conducted with mothers every six months. This was very helpful for us and more organizations should arrange this program with Garima team."

MUKTI- FIGHTING PERIOD POVERTY

Addressing the needs of menstruating children and women fighting period poverty with the goal to have a safe, green period and to #bleedwithdignity. Conducted awareness workshops, distributed free sustainable products (reusable cloth pad sets or period cups) and provided medical care as needed by members.

Reached 150 persons with Project Mukti:

- Awareness workshops and free product distribution 150 members
- Medical camp and assistance provided 100 members

SULTANA'S DREAM- STOP CHILD MARRIAGE!- A STREETPLAY

Scripted by Garima, this musical play is a loose rendition of the 1905 Bangla feminist utopian story *Sultana's Dream written by Begum Rokeya*. It was directed by our team and performed by children of informal workers, raising demands to stop child marriages and child labour in their communities through theatre, music and dance.

The play has reached 1500+ community members.








UDAAN- COMPREHENSIVE SEX AND GENDER EDUCATION (CSGE)


